

## Berkeley College – Tuition Discount Program

Berkeley College is offering a Tuition Discount for Metro YMCA employees and their immediate family members who enroll in on-site or online degree programs. Details of the program follow:

- a. **Up to 30%.** The award will be the lesser of 30% of tuition or the balance of tuition after any applicable federal grants, state grants, VA benefits, employer benefits, and/or outside scholarships are applied.
- b. **Open to all Metro YMCA employees and/or their immediate family members** (spouse/partner and children).
- c. Only applies to associate's, bachelor's, and the Master of Business Administration – Management degree programs.
  - i. Does not apply to the LPN to B.S.N program.
  - ii. Does not apply to certificate programs or continuing education.
- d. Does not cover fees.
- e. Tuition discount may be combined with a limited number of Berkeley College grants, as applicable and based on eligibility.
- f. **The tuition discount will apply only after the student has enrolled, met with a Financial Aid counselor, and submitted the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).**
- g. Not all programs are offered for completion at each campus or through Berkeley College Online®. Employees should review the Berkeley College academic program information, available on [berkeleycollege.edu](http://berkeleycollege.edu), for details on where each program is offered. Additionally, students may be required to take some courses at another campus or online.
- h. **Employees must identify themselves when applying to Berkeley in order to take advantage of the tuition discount benefits. Proof of employment is required**, which may include a pay stub, employee ID or Organization email address. Employees who choose to enroll are solely responsible for all tuition charges and fees.
- i. **Employees who separate from Metro YMCA but remain enrolled at Berkeley will no longer be eligible to receive the tuition discount.** Such individuals will be subject to the College's current published tuition rates in subsequent academic terms, except as provided by the College's Tuition Freeze Policies.
